
Remember to use gloves. For easy sorting/weighing dump waste bags out on a plastic cover and sort in to buckets. After sorting, recycle the items that can be recycled!

# Classroom Tips

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Do your part at school and at home with our useful tips and tricks.



Create a classroom library where pupils can bring in their old books so that others can borrow them instead of buying their own copy.



Use a reusable bottle and lunch box instead of waxed paper, sandwich bags or aliminium foil. This reduces waste and keeps your lunch fresh!



Involve pupils by inviting them to create posters and bright labels for each of the different bins in the classroom.



Start a recycling club!
This is a great way to incentivise healthy competition between pupils and bring more awareness to recycling.



Make your paper last twice as long by using both sides! If you only need to use one side, save the paper in a "reuse" box.



Put lids on pens and markers to increase their lifetime. Discourage using stickers, decorative tape and consumables that can create waste.

Calling all schools! Bord na Móna Recycling invite entries to the 'Schools Upcycling Competition', an educational challenge designed to provide students with a platform to raise awareness about upcycling as an environmentally friendly practice while fostering creativity and innovative thinking. Schools are encouraged to show their ability to repurpose discarded materials into innovative and functional creations.

The winning class will receive a guided tour of Lough Boora Discovery Park which includes entry to the sculpture park and a field study, featuring a nature walk and examination of local flora and wildlife. This will be followed by a tour of Mountlucas Wind Farm, including entry to the interactive learning hub, a VR turbine tour and the chance to see a turbine up close! A prize of €5,000 will also be awarded to the winning school.





#### Eligibility:

- The competition is open to students from primary schools in the Republic of Ireland.
- Entries can be made individually, in teams, or as a class.
- Participants must use materials that would typically be considered waste or discarded items.
- Suggested categories include; Home Decor, Fashion and Accessories, Functional Tools or Gadgets and Artistic Creations.
