1. By entering this competition, you agree to accept and be bound by these terms and conditions. All entry instructions form part of the terms and conditions of this competition. Entries that do not comply may be disqualified.
2. This competition is open to primary schools in the Republic of Ireland only.
3. This competition is open to students aged 4 to 13 years on 1st of January 2024.
4. Entries must feature materials that are typically considered waste or used.
5. Only one entry per student is permitted. This may come as part of a team or an individual entry.
6. Entries must not contain hazardous waste or any material that could harm students.
7. Unsuccessful entrants/schools will receive a certificate via email.
8. It is not possible for feedback to be provided for unsuccessful entries.
9. No corrections or alterations can be made after receipt of an entry.
10. All entries must be the original work of the entrants and must not infringe the rights of any other party.
11. Entry opens on the 15th of January 2024. Entry closes at 5pm on the 1st of May 2024. Entries received after the closing date will not be considered.
